Circulation

Since school began in September, we have circulated nearly 5,000 books! The most popular categories are picture books, fiction, biographies, weather, space, animals, and sports. Students visit regularly with their classes, and may also come to morning checkout before school starts. Highland View students are great readers!

Kindergarten

Kindergarten students learned about the difference between fiction and nonfiction, having a growth mindset, staying safe online, and different characters in fiction. They often complete coloring sheets about the book we read that week.

1st Grade

1st grade students learned about having a growth mindset, staying safe online, and focused for two weeks on people who became involved in their communities.

2nd Grade

2nd grade completed a research project on monuments where they learned about famous monuments, researched biographies of famous Americans, and drew their ideas for new monuments. They also learned about problems and solutions in fiction.

Grades 3-5 visit regularly for book checkout and have special scheduled media time for projects

3rd and 4th Grades

3rd and 4th grade students learned about participating in government, American history, memorable characters in fiction, and folk tales.

5th Grade

5th grade students completed a research project on the Presidential Medal of Freedom where they researched past winners, researched potential winners they chose themselves, and presented their findings in posters.
